

**LECTORS AND COMMENTATORS** are volunteers who proclaim God's Word during Catholic Mass. A **LECTOR** reads the scripture readings and the responsorial psalm. A **COMMENTATOR** handles the introductory announcements, welcomes the congregation, reads the Prayers of the Faithful, and provides concluding remarks. Both roles require preparation, training, and a commitment to living out their faith.

### Lector

Primary Role: Proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture, except for the Gospel, which is read by a deacon or

Other Duties: Can also be asked to recite the Responsorial Psalm and the Prayers of the Faithful in the absence of the psalmist or deacon.

**Preparation**: Should be well-versed in the readings, which may include practicing, studying the background, and understanding pronunciation guides.

### Commentator

Primary Role: Manages the flow of the Mass by making announcements and introductions.

Other Duties: Welcome attendees, read the mass intentions, and lead the Prayers of the Faithful if no deacon is present.

Preparation: Needs to be organized and clear in their delivery of information to the congregation.

### Requirements and Training

Faith and Practice: Lectors and commentators are expected to be practicing Catholics who live in accordance with the Church's teachings.

Training: Proper formation and training are required before one can serve in this ministry.

**Commitment**: This is a commitment to a particular Mass time and involves regular service.
