The readings this Sunday focus on themes of trust, resurrection, and true happiness. The readings highlight the importance of relying on God and the hope found in Jesus Christ's resurrection.

- Trust in God: Jeremiah warns against trusting in human strength and calls for trust in God. True happiness comes from relying on God, not on ourselves.
- Blessings and Curses: Jeremiah speaks about the blessings for those who trust in God and the curses for those who trust in humans. These verses remind us to seek blessings through faith in God.
- Resurrection Hope: In 1 Corinthians, Paul defends the resurrection of Jesus. He explains that our faith de pends on the truth of Jesus rising from the dead.
- **Eternal Life**: Paul emphasizes that without the resurrect tion, our faith is useless. The resurrection gives us hope for eternal life with Jesus.
- True Happiness: In Luke, Jesus teaches about the bless ings of the poor and hungry. He contrasts their future joy with the sorrow of the rich and satisfied.
- Warnings of Woe: Jesus warns those who are rich, full, and laughing now. Their comfort is temporary, and they need to seek true happiness in God.

The readings for this Sunday encourage us to trust in God and find hope in Jesus' resurrection. They remind us that true happiness is found in faith and reliance on God, not in worldly things.
