MARCH 29, 2026 * PALM SUNDAY

Palm Sunday,

officially "Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord," is the final Sunday of Lent and the start of Holy Week in the Catholic Church, commemorating Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. It combines joy (welcoming Jesus) and sorrow (reflecting on his impending Passion). The day is marked by the blessing and distribution of palm branches, a special procession, and the reading of the Passion narrative.

KEY ASPECTS & USAGE EXAMPLES IN CATHOLIC TRADITION:

Blessing of Palms: Faithful receive/brings palms to symbolize victory and peace.

Procession: A procession, often starting outside the church, commemorates Christ's entrance into Jerusalem.

The Passion Reading: The gospel reading tells the story of Christ's betrayal, trial, and death, focusing on the Passion.

Customary Practices: Many Catholics bring blessed palms home to place on a crucifix, or braid them, then return them to the church to be burned into ashes for the following year's Ash Wednesday.

Symbols: Palms symbolize the victory of Christ, while the donkey represents humility.

On Palm Sunday, we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and the events leading to his death. The readings show his humility, suffering, and obedience to God.

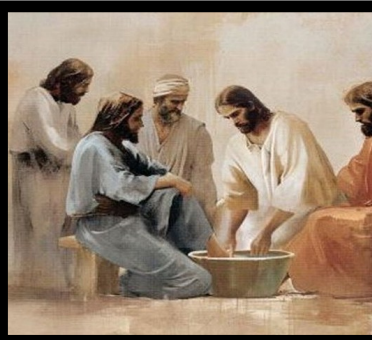
- **Jesus as King:** The people welcomed Jesus as a king, but he came in humility, riding a donkey. This shows that his kingship is different from earthly rulers.
- **Obedience to God:** Jesus followed God's will, even when it led to suffering and death. His obedience shows trust in God's plan.
- **Betrayal and Denial:** Judas betrayed Jesus, and Peter denied knowing him. These show human weakness and the need for mercy.
- **Suffering and Sacrifice:** Jesus endured pain, humiliation, and death on the cross. His suffering was an act of love for others.
- **God's Victory:** Jesus' death was not the end. God raised him up, showing that good is stronger than evil.
- **Jesus as Servant:** He did not seek power or glory. He humbled himself and served others, even in suffering.

Palm Sunday calls us to follow Jesus' example of humility, obedience, and love. We are reminded that suffering is not the end, but God brings hope and new life.
