





The readings this Sunday highlights the call to care for others and shine in the world. They show how kindness, faith, and good actions bring light and hope.

- **Helping those in need:** Giving food, shelter, and clothing to others brings healing and joy. When people help those who suffer, they find peace and feel closer to God.
- **Living by faith:** Faith should rest on God's power, not on human knowledge. Trusting in Him gives strength, even when feeling weak.
- **Being a light:** Jesus calls people to shine by doing good. When others see kindness and love, they are drawn closer to God.
- **Making a difference:** Just as salt changes food, people can change the world. Small acts of goodness bring hope and encouragement.
- **Showing God's love:** Faith is not just words but actions. Loving others reflects God's goodness in everyday life.
- **Overcoming fear with trust:** Weakness and fear should not stop people from sharing their faith. Trusting in God's help brings courage.
- **Glorifying God:** Good works should not be done for attention. They should point others to God and His goodness.

Today we are reminded to share, trust, and shine. When we live with kindness and faith, we bring hope to the world.

**STEWARDSHIP MINISTRY** is a parish-based initiative rooted in discipleship, teaching Catholics to live gratefully by developing and sharing their God-given gifts (Time, Talent, Treasure) to serve others, build the Church, and glorify God, moving beyond mere fundraising to a holistic, transformative way of life centered on generosity and active participation in parish and community life.

### Core Principles:

**A Way of Life:** It's a spiritual discipline and call to action, not just financial giving, focusing on how we live daily.

**Grateful Response:** Recognizing everything as a gift from God and responding with gratitude.

**Time, Talent, Treasure:** Using one's time (service), talents (abilities/passions), and treasure (financial gifts) responsibly.

**Discipleship:** Imitating Jesus by serving others and building His Kingdom, fostering a deeper relationship with God.

### Key Activities & Goals:

**Spiritual Growth:** Encourages prayer, service, and a conversion of heart.

**Community Building:** Fosters connection through shared service and broader participation in ministries.

**Parish Vitality:** Invites involvement in activities, outreach, and leadership.

**Biblical Foundation:** Draws from scripture, particularly Jesus' parables, emphasizing stewardship.

**Resource Management:** Teaches responsible use and sharing of material and human resources.

### How it Works in Parishes:

**Stewardship Committees:** Groups often formed to guide this culture.

**Education:** Using resources like the US Bishops' pastoral letter, "Stewardship: A Disciple's Response".

**Witness:** Parishioners share personal stories of stewardship.

In essence, a Catholic Stewardship Ministry aims to transform a parish into a vibrant, generous community where everyone understands their unique role in God's plan, using their whole lives as an offering.


